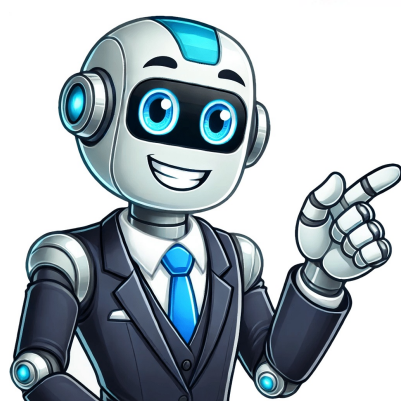

Google Analytics collects data from your websites and apps to create reports that provide insights into your business. You can use reports to monitor traffic, investigate data, and understand your users and their activity. Once Analytics starts to receive data, the data appears in the Realtime report and then in your other reports shortly after. Some of the data in your reports is collected from your websites and apps once you set up Google Analytics, while other data requires some additional setup. You can find all your reports by clicking Reports on the left. Watch a video about Google Analytics reports Get started When you open your reports, you will see a Reports snapshot report, a Realtime report, and a number of predefined reports. Everyone with access to your Google Analytics will see the same set of reports on the left. Google Analytics provides two types of reports: Overview reports: These reports summarize data about a topic: for example, see how much you're making across ecommerce purchases, in-app purchases, and mobile ads. Detail reports: These reports provide more in-depth information about an area of interest; for example, see in-depth data about ecommerce purchases. Copyright ownership gives the owner the exclusive right to use the work, with some exceptions. When a person creates an original work, fixed in a tangible medium, he or she automatically owns copyright to the work. Many types of works are eligible for copyright protection, for example: Audiovisual works, such as TV shows, movies, and online videos Sound recordings and musical compositions Written works, such as lectures, articles, books, and musical compositions Visual works, such as paintings, posters, and advertisements Video games and computer software Dramatic works, such as plays and musicals The Copyright Office has information online, and you can check with a lawyer if you want to know more. Can I use content from a work thats protected by copyright? Copyright holders have the right to control most uses of their works. In some circumstances, it's possible to use a copyright-protected work without infringing their copyright: You've checked with the copyright holder, who has allowed you to use the content. It's a good idea to get written permission from them, for example, in the form of a license agreement. Some copyright holders make their works available to others for uncompensated reuse, with a few requirements. To learn more, you can read about Creative Commons licenses. In some cases, you can use content from a work thats protected by copyright without getting permission from the copyright holder. That's because some uses of copyrighted works are considered "fair use" or may fall within a limitation or exception to copyright law such as fair dealing. If you're not sure whether the use youre considering is legal without permission, you may wish to consult a lawyer. What if I state that "no copyright infringement is intended"? If you don't have permission to use copyright-protected work, your content could still be removed even if: You gave credit to the copyright holder. When giving permission to use their work, some copyright holders ask that you do this. In some cases, you may also need to credit the copyright holder if you plan to use their work in a way that you consider fair use or fair dealing. However, this doesn't automatically give you the right to use the content without permission. You bought the content, including a physical or digital copy. Owning a copy means you might be able to sell that copy or give it to a friend, but it doesn't give you the right to publicly share that content with the entire internet. You're not making a profit from the content. While it's more likely that non-commercial use can be considered fair use, or might satisfy the requirements of some licenses, not making a profit alone doesnt always mean your use is non-infringing. You've seen similar content elsewhere on the internet. Those other users might have gotten permission to share the content, or they may be using the content in a way that can be considered fair use. You recorded the content yourself from the TV, a movie theater, or the radio. Making your own copy from one of these sources doesn't give you the rights to the underlying content. You copied the content yourself from a textbook, a movie poster, or a photograph. As with the above, making your own copy doesn't give you the rights to the underlying content. You've stated that "no copyright infringement is intended." This never helps. Copyright infringement is a "strict liability" offense. This means that when the courts decide whether there was copyright infringement, they dont look at whether you intended to infringe or not. Can Google determine copyright ownership? No. Google isn't able to mediate rights ownership disputes. When we receive a complete and valid takedown notice, we remove the content as the law requires. When we receive a valid counter notification we forward it to the person who requested the removal. If there's still a dispute, it's up to the parties involved to resolve the issue in court. What's the difference between copyright & trademark? What about patents? Copyright is just one form of intellectual property. It isn't the same as trademark, which protects brand names, mottos, logos, and other source identifiers from being used by others for certain purposes. It's also different from patent law, which protects inventions. What's the difference between copyright & privacy? Just because you appear in a video, image, or audio recording doesn't mean you own the copyright to it. For example, if your friend took a picture of you, she would own the copyright to the image that she took. If your friend, or someone else, uploaded a video, image or recording of you without your permission, and you feel it violates your privacy or safety, you may wish to file a privacy complaint. The easiest way to file a complaint is to use our legal troubleshooter. Copyright notifications must include the following elements. Without this information, we will be unable to take action on your request: 1. Your contact information You'll need to provide information that will allow us to contact you regarding your complaint, such as an email address, physical address, or telephone number. 2. A description of your work that you believe has been infringed In your complaint, be sure to clearly and completely describe the copyrighted content you're seeking to protect. If multiple copyrighted works are covered in your complaint, the law allows a representative list of such works. 3. Each allegedly infringing URL Your complaint must contain the specific URL of the content you believe infringes your rights, or we'll be unable to locate it. General information about the location of the content isn't adequate. Please include the URL(s) of the exact content at issue. 4. You must agree to and affirm both of the following statements: "I have a good faith belief that use of the copyrighted materials described above as allegedly infringing is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law." "The information in this notification is accurate and I swear, under penalty of perjury, that I am the copyright owner or am authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed." 5. Your signature Complete complaints require the physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or a representative authorized to act on their behalf. To satisfy this requirement, you may type your full legal name to act as your signature at the bottom of your complaint. If someone accidentally adds dots to your address when emailing you, you'll still get that email. For example, if your email is johnsmith@gmail.com, you own all dotted versions of your address: john.smith@gmail.com jo.hn.sm.ith@gmail.com j.o.h.n.s.m.i.t.h@gmail.com Note: If you use Gmail through work, school, or other organization (like yourdomain.com or yourschool.edu), dots do change your address. To change the dots in your username, contact your admin. No one else gets your emails Your Gmail address is unique. If anyone tries to create a Gmailaccount with a dotted version of your username, they'll get an error saying the username is already taken. For example, if your addressis johnsmith@gmail.com, no one can sign up forj.o.h.n.s.m.i.t.h@gmail.com. Your account is still private and secure. Emails sent to any dotted version of your address will only go to you. For example, johnsmith@gmail.com and j.o.h.n.s.m.i.t.h@gmail.com are the same address and go to oneinbox. What to do if you get someone else's mail Adding dots doesn't change your address, so dots aren't why you got someone else's mail. Instead, the sender probably mistyped or forgot the correct address. For example, if someone meant to email john.43.smith@gmail.com but typed john.smith@gmail.com, the message went to you because you own johnsmith@gmail.com. If the email seems irrelevant but not suspicious, reply to the sender saying they have the wrong address. Do not click any links or share personal information. Report the email as spam or phishing. Contact the website to remove your address from their mailing list. Learn how to unsubscribe from emails. Note: Unfortunately, we can't prevent people from accidentally or maliciously using a dotted version of your address to sign up for subscription emails.
