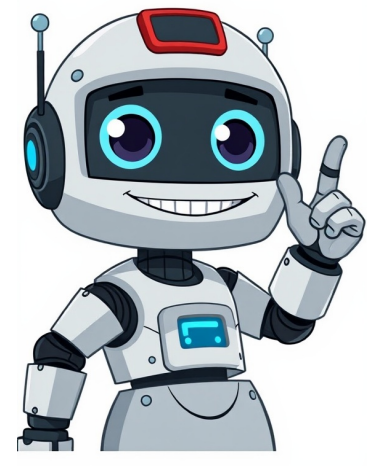

Comments section for each lesson and challenge is gold. I feel like im actually learning python Weaknesses: Though free, it seems somewhat limited. The tutorials are often lacking or lack relevant information to accomplish the next task. That said, the comment sections have gotten me out of many binds. The layout and design of the site is lacking compared to say, codecademy, which i value if im spending a couple hours working through these lessons. again, im just a beginner, but if anyone has any relevant questions, please feel free to ask.
